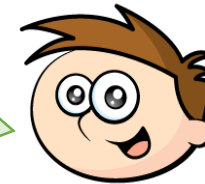
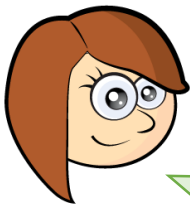


Both children are correct.

The greater the digit sum, the greater the number.



The greater the tens digit, the greater the number.



# False

Both children are incorrect.

A number with more tens is not always larger,  
for example 319 is larger than 291.

A number with a larger digit sum is not always larger,  
for example 199 has a larger digit sum than 301,  
but it is a smaller number.
