

MAKE A PAPER SCULPTURE

Cut up some paper scraps and make a 3D sculpture.

YOU WILL NEED

- A cereal box or some cardboard for the base
- Some coloured paper, newspaper, scrap paper or old wrapping paper
- Glue stick
- Scissors

If you don't have some of these things, think about how you could creatively use something different. Could you tear paper instead of using scissors? Could you use blue tac or tape instead of glue? If you have child scissors, make sure you are still with an adult when cutting. If you only have adult scissors an adult must do the cutting for you!
