

Science Lesson 2

We have studied about food chains this half term. If one part of the food chain changes or is removed it can cause big problems. Here is an example of a food chain:



Lettuce → Slug → Hedgehog → Fox

A gardener has put down poison to kill the slugs and stop them from eating her lettuce.

What will happen to each part of the food chain? In your home learning book tell me what would happen to the lettuce, the hedgehogs and the foxes.
