You have the choice to complete Task 1 **OR** Task 2. You do not have to complete both.

Task 1 is to make a model of the journey of a river using objects you have in your house.

Here are some examples:



Other creative ideas you could try:

- Use your blue school jumper to make the river or a lake
- Use a pair of tights to make the river
- Use shoelaces to make the river
- Use cushions or pillows to build a mountain where you would find the source of your river
- Use cushions or pillows to build a V shaped valley

Task 2 is to go on a river scavenger hunt around your home and find different objects to represent features of a river's journey. You could take photos to email to your teacher or draw a picture and write about them in your home learning book.
